





Fig.1 Power Dissipation Derating Curve




Fig.2 Maximum Safe Operating Area





Fig.3 Typical Transient Thermal Impedance vs. Pulse Width



Pulse Width: PW [s]






Fig.5 T_{vj} = 25°C 3rd Quadrant Characteristics



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


Fig.8 Body Diode Forward Voltage vs. Gate - Source Voltage




Fig.9 Typical Transfer Characteristics (I)




Fig.10 Typical Transfer Characteristics (II)




Fig.11 Gate Threshold Voltage vs. Virtual Junction Temperature






Fig.12 Transconductance vs. Drain Current









Fig.14 Static Drain - Source On - State

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


Fig.19 Dynamic Input Characteristics




Fig.20 Typical Switching Time vs. External Gate Resistance 120 = 25°C = 15A $t_{d(off)}$ 100 $V_{DD} = 800V$ $V_{GS} = +18V/0V$ Switching Time : t [ns] $= 250 \mu H$ 80 60 $t_{d(o\underline{n})} \\$ 40 j t, i 20 ¦ t_f 0 5 10 15 20 External Gate Resistance : $R_G[\Omega]$

Fig.1-1 Gate Charge Measurement Circuit




Fig.2-1 Switching Characteristics Measurement Circuit




Fig.2-3 Waveforms for Switching Energy Loss




Fig.3-1 Reverse Recovery Time Measurement Circuit




Fig.1-2 Gate Charge Waveform




Fig.2-2 Waveforms for Switching Time







Fig.3-2 Reverse Recovery Waveform




