

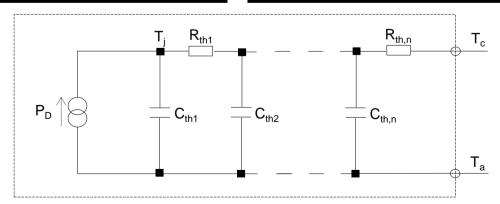



Fig.1 Power Dissipation Derating Curve




Fig.2 Maximum Safe Operating Area





Fig.3 Typical Transient Thermal Impedance vs. Pulse Width



Pulse Width: PW [s]






Fig.5 T_{vi} = 25°C 3rd Quadrant Characteristics 0








Fig.8 Body Diode Forward Voltage vs. Gate - Source Voltage




Fig.9 Typical Transfer Characteristics (I)




Fig.10 Typical Transfer Characteristics (II)




Fig.11 Gate Threshold Voltage vs. Virtual Junction Temperature




Fig.12 Transconductance vs. Drain Current




Fig.13 Static Drain - Source On - State Resistance vs. Gate - Source Voltage




Fig.14 Static Drain - Source On - State Resistance vs. Virtual Junction Temperature




Fig.15 Static Drain - Source On - State Resistance vs. Drain Current






Fig.16 Normalized Drain - Source Breakdown Voltage vs. Virtual Junction








Fig.19 Dynamic Input Characteristics




Fig.20 Typical Switching Time vs. External Gate Resistance





Fig.21 Typical Switching Loss vs. Drain - Source Voltage

Fig.22 Typical Switching Loss vs. Drain Current





Fig.23 Typical Switching Loss vs. External Gate Resistance

Fig.1-1 Gate Charge Measurement Circuit

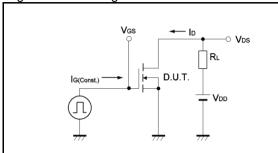


Fig.2-1 Switching Characteristics Measurement Circuit




Fig.2-3 Waveforms for Switching Energy Loss




Fig.3-1 Reverse Recovery Time Measurement Circuit




Fig.1-2 Gate Charge Waveform




Fig.2-2 Waveforms for Switching Time







Fig.3-2 Reverse Recovery Waveform




